Introduction

- The Fruit of Goodness and Faithfulness
 - Goodness is integrity or completeness and wholeness of character where what we do shows what we are.
 - Faithfulness is dependability and trustworthiness over time, a track record of goodness.
- Weeds
 - The *opposite* of goodness and faithfulness is hypocrisy: where our self-perception and other people's perception of us do not reflect or project accurately who we are.
 - *<u>Counterfeit</u>* goodness and faithfulness is:
 - manipulative or self-serving good deeds
 - Phony and shallow relationships
- Fertilizer
 - Contemplating God's goodness and faithfulness in creation, providence, and redemption
